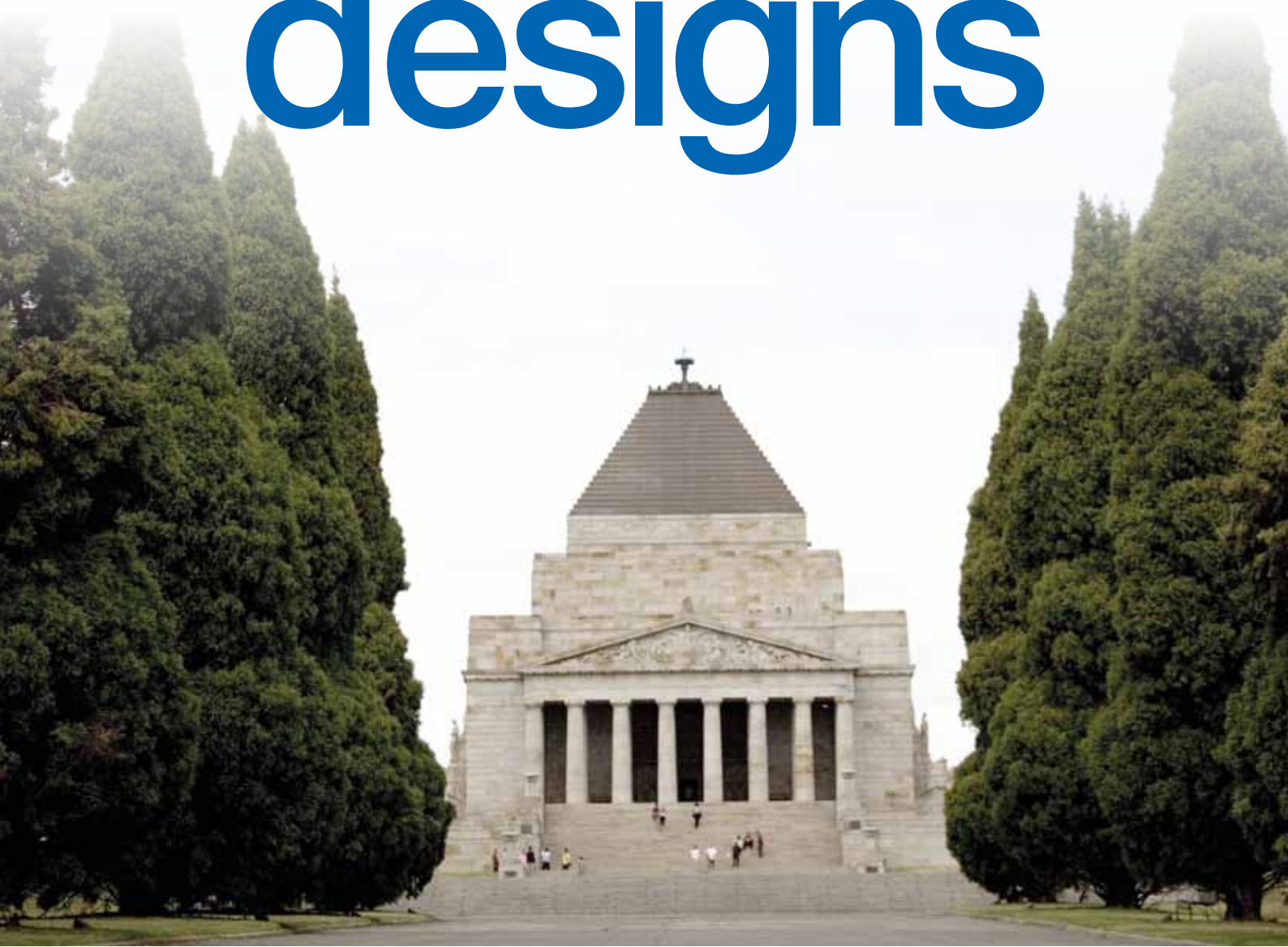


Grand designs

- A** **University of Melbourne** - Early on in the city's history, the University of Melbourne decided that Neo - Gothic would be the standard for all their buildings. This really is an example of Gothic architecture at its best. unimelb.edu.au
- B** **Royal Exhibition Building** - One of the world's oldest remaining exhibition pavilions and a reminder of Melbourne's decadent gold rush era. museumvictoria.com.au
- C** **State Library** - An iconic, Melbourne city landmark - outside and in. Be sure to check out The La Trobe Reading Room - the majestic domed ceiling is a delight. slv.vic.gov.au
- D** **Federation Square** - An architectural overload - home to ACMI, SBS and The Ian Potter Centre. fedsquare.com
- E** **Eureka Tower** - The highest viewing platform in the Southern Hemisphere. Don't look down! eurekaskydeck.com.au
- F** **The Shrine of Remembrance** - A dedication to the Australian World War 1 armed forces. Designed by two ex- soldiers and inspired by one of the seven wonders of the ancient world, the Mausoleum at Halicarnassus. shrine.org.au
