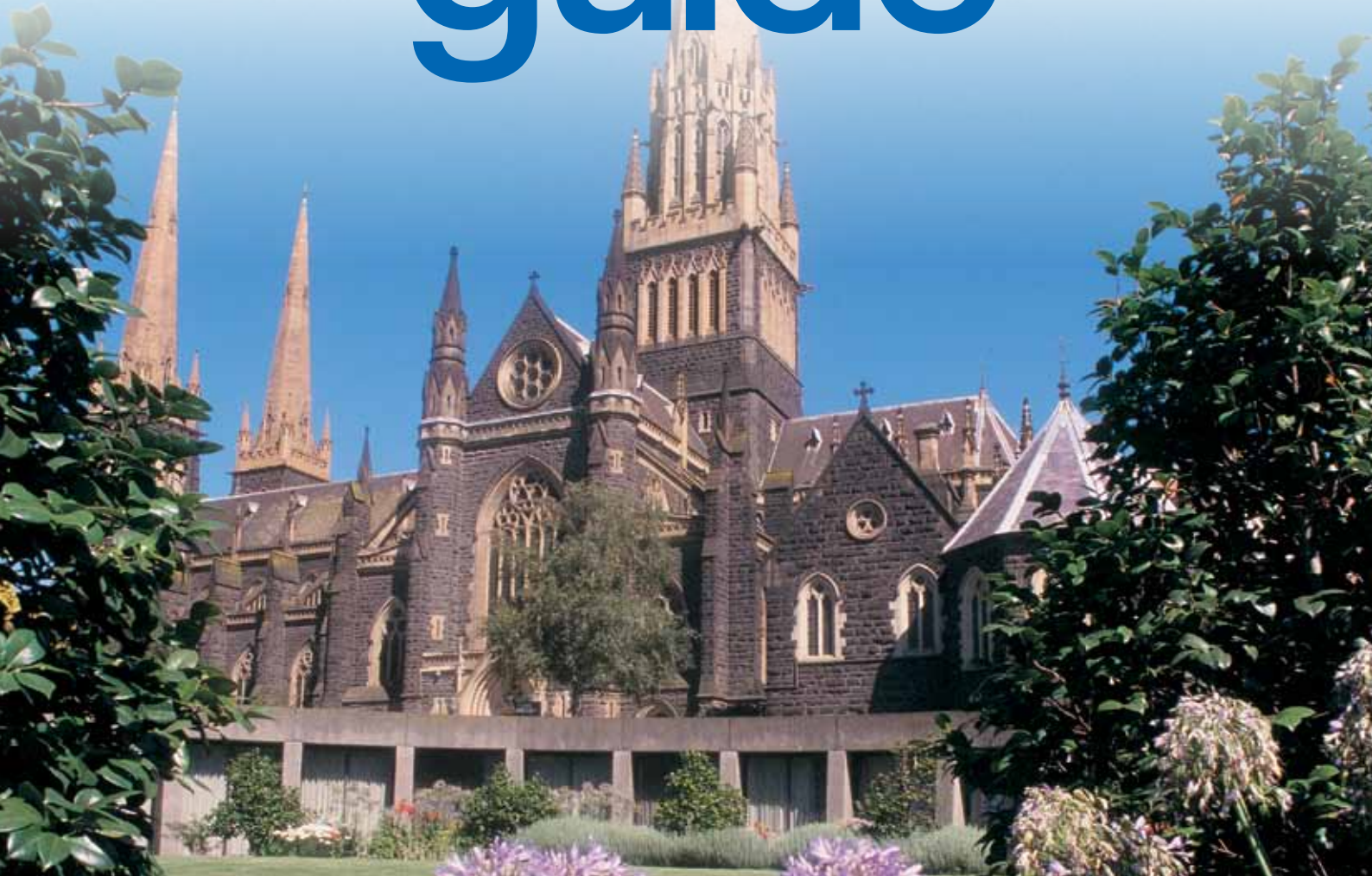


Spiritual guide









Melbourne is a cultural melting pot, nurturing a variety of faiths. The city's religious buildings offer both a peaceful haven to worship and contribute to its rich architectural heritage.

- A** **St. Paul's Cathedral** - An Anglican, Neo-Gothic haven opposite Flinders Street Station - truly at the heart of city life. stpaulscathedral.org.au
- B** **Scots' Church** - Another Neo-Gothic homage. This was Victoria's first Presbyterian church. scotschurch.com
- C** **St. Michael's Uniting Church** - Come marvel at the largest display of religious stained glass in Australia. stmichaels.org.au
- D** **St. Patrick's Cathedral** - A sanctuary for many of Melbourne's earliest Irish Roman Catholic immigrants. stpatrickscathedral.org.au
- E** **Melbourne City Synagogue** - The oldest functioning synagogue, serving Melbourne's vibrant Jewish community. melbournecitysynagogue.com
- F** **Melbourne West Mosque** - Melbourne's inner city mosque offering prayer facilities for the city's thriving Muslim population. icv.org.au
